

Brockwood Park School Fees

Academic Year 2024-25

Brockwood Park School is a small school and unique in its intentions and educational offering. This is only made possible due to a dedicated staff working for low salaries, plus contributions by donors and volunteers. There is a generous bursary programme, making sure the School is open for as wide a group of applicants as possible and ensuring the diverse international student body vital to its ethos. In order for this to continue, we expect families who can afford it to pay the full fees and, if possible, to further assist financially in helping secure the future of the school.

Bursaries are not based on academic performance but are means-tested and depend on the financial circumstances of the family. In the first year, up to 50% may be offered by the school and in exceptional circumstances this offer is raised. For our returning students, there are more bursaries available and offers are sometimes raised.

The school fees are £37,850 per year.

Additional Payments: Required for school outings, examinations, extra lessons, Special Educational Needs (SEN) sessions/classes, materials, one-to-one music tuition, etc. In addition, £50 per term for sundry goods (such as stamps, stationery etc.) is payable for all students.

Application Fee: A non-refundable application fee of £50 is payable for all applicants upon completing the online application.

Registration Fee: For UK students, a non-refundable registration fee of £280 is payable upon your child's enrolment at the school. For EU, EEA, Swiss and International students, who require a visa, a non-refundable registration and visa administration fee of £480 is payable upon your child's enrolment at the school. In rare circumstances, when it is needed to apply for a visa again during your child's stay at the school, an additional £480 is payable.

Acceptance Refundable Deposit: A refundable deposit of £1,300 is payable upon acceptance of your child's place at the School. The deposit will be returned to you when your child has left the School, providing that they leave in accordance with the School's Fees Terms & Conditions (see below). The deposit cannot be refunded if your child accepts the place but then does not enrol at the School.

Sibling Discount: A 15% Sibling Discount applies for the second and any subsequent siblings whilst they are enrolled simultaneously.

Textbooks: There is an additional cost for textbooks, but these can be ordered through the School at a discounted price.

Examinations incur a cost at the following rates: approximately £30 per AS Level exam, approximately £40 per A Level exam, approximately £30 for SAT exams, and £65-£75 for Cambridge ESL exams.
