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1. Use of Cookies by the Krishnamurti Foundation Trust

To help our website work properly and improve your experience, we sometimes place small data files called cookies on the device you use. Many websites do this. This policy explains what cookies are, which ones we use, and how you can control them, in line with the Privacy and Electronic Communications Regulations 2003 (PECR), as amended by the Data (Use and Access) Act 2025, and the UK GDPR.

1.1. What are cookies?

A cookie is a small text file that a website saves on your computer, tablet, or mobile device when you visit. It enables the website to remember your actions and preferences (such as

login, language, font size, and display settings) over a period of time, so you don't have to re-enter them whenever you return to the site or move between pages.

1.2. Types of cookies we use

We use the following categories of cookies:

Cookie Type	Purpose	Example	Retention	Lawful Basis
Strictly necessary	Enable core site functions such as security, network management, and accessibility	Session ID	Session only	Legitimate interests
Functional	Remember your preferences and settings	Language choice	6 months	Consent
Analytics	Help us understand how visitors use our site so we can improve it	Google Analytics (IP anonymised)	12 months	Consent
Embedded content	Enable videos, maps, or social media feeds	YouTube video player	Varies by provider	Consent

We do not use cookies for targeted advertising or profiling.

1.3. How we obtain consent

On your first visit, you will see a cookie banner allowing you to:

- Accept all cookies
- Reject non-essential cookies
- Manage your preferences

Non-essential cookies will only be set if you give consent. You can change your preferences at any time via the "Cookie Settings" link in the site footer.

1.4. How to control cookies

You can control and/or delete cookies as you wish – see www.aboutcookies.org or your browser's help section. You can delete all cookies already on your device and set most browsers to prevent them from being placed. If you do this, you may have to manually adjust some preferences each time you visit, and some services or features may not work.

1.5. Children's privacy

As our site may be accessed by parents, carers, and students, we follow the ICO's Children's code (Age Appropriate Design Code). We do not knowingly use cookies to track or profile children. Any analytics data is anonymised and used only to improve our services.
